## Conditions of Entry:

The event will be run according to the Speedway New Zealand Rule Book.

All drivers must hold current SNZ Inc Licence's and all vehicles must comply with the Speedway New Zealand Rule Book and supplementary regulations.

The Promoter reserves the right to issue **temporary numbers** to avoid duplication. Competitors will be advised of any such change to their racing number. It is a condition of entry that competing vehicles arrive at vehicle checking displaying the number allocated to them and that the numbers comply with the rules of Speedway New Zealand Inc. (no cardboard / paper numbers)

Noise levels will be adhered to as per the current Speedway New Zealand Rule Book. A maximum noise level of 95dba will be strictly enforced.

**Technical Inspections:** Please pay attention to rules E2-3-1 to E2-3-5.

In the event that you have forwarded an entry form and you discover that you cannot attend, you **must** notify the promoter of your inability to honour this contract **IN ADVANCE**. The WSSCC would advise all Competitors to enter early, even if you are not sure if you will make it. We prefer you withdraw your entry than try to enter late. *(Refer below regarding late entries.)*

Huntly International Speedway has Dorian Electronic Lap scoring and Race Receivers will be in place and will be using it to

Lap score and communicate with all cars in the championship. It is compulsory for all cars to arrive at vehicle checking with **Dorian Transmitters and Race Receivers** in place and working.

**PROPOSED FORMAT: Practice Thursday: 13th February 2020 at 7pm**

**PROPOSED FORMAT: Qualifying: Friday 14<sup>th</sup> February 2020**

Qualifying to find the top 20 cars who will contest the New Zealand Saloon Title will involve competitors being split into 6 groups, depending on entries received. Computer Software will create random Grid Draws for the 15 Heat Races.

Race Format:

- Drivers will be split into 6 groups. These will be seeded by the Promotion.
- Each group will Race 5 Heats (Friday 3 Heats of 12 laps. (Saturday 2 Heats of 12 laps)
- Grid positions on Friday for Heat 1 will be Computer draw. Points will be awarded from 20 points for 1st place, 19 points for 2nd place, 18 points for 3rd and so on down.

Heat 1 A - B	Heat 2 A - C	Heat 3 B - C
C - E	B - F	A - D
D - F	D - E	E - F

- Grid positions for Saturday nights heats will be

Heat 4 B - D	Heat 5 B - E
A - E	C - D
C - F	A - F

- The top 16 point's scorers from all entries will qualify for the Championship Final of 25 laps.
- The highest points from the Heats will determine Grid positions for the Feature Event. From Grid 1 to grid 16. If at any time drivers are tied on points from qualifying. It will be decided by the fastest Lap Time.
- All remaining drivers will compete in 1 of 2 Repercharge of 12 laps. The makeup of these 2 Repercharge will be based on points. Whoever is 17<sup>th</sup>, 19<sup>th</sup> & so on in points will be in Repercharge A and whoever is 18<sup>th</sup>, 20<sup>th</sup> & so on in points will be in Repercharge B
- The first 2 finishers of each Repercharge will qualify for the Championship Final and fill grid positions 17 to 20. First Repercharge grid positions in finishing order will take up grid positions 17, and 19. Second Repercharge grid positions in finishing order will take up grid positions 18 and 20.
